The joint technologies enable customers to securely connect industrial equipment to IoT platforms without the need for cellular data, reliably from almost anywhere on the planet for a simple fixed fee.

"For now the most common wireless connectivity option is cellular (GSM) data, however this creates friction for both companies delivering remote or mobile, and unnecessary costs for end customers" explains Neil Hamilton, VP of Business Development at Thingstream. "Choosing which provider to match an application's footprint is particularly difficult, especially considering coverage varies so much between providers. Costs can quickly rack up if industrial equipment is mobile and requires a roaming SIM for international use."

Many industrial companies however are hesitant about connecting devices due to cyber security and cost challenges. We are delighted to be working with Eurotech.
